

From Groundbreaking to Game Time: Building New Nissan Stadium

As the NFL and college football seasons are in full swing and the playoffs are approaching, we're thrilled to announce we've been awarded the new Nissan Stadium in Nashville, TN. This state-of-the-art venue will serve as the future home for both the Tennessee Titans and the Tennessee State University football teams.

This stadium is designed to deliver the ultimate fan experience. With a seating capacity of approximately 60,000, it features an enclosed translucent roof to host events year-round. The stadium also boasts multiple premium areas and suites, along with expansive glass walls and exterior terraces that offer stunning views of downtown Nashville.

This will be Gephart's third NFL stadium project and our second major sports facility in the Nashville area in the last five years after completing the MLS GEODIS Park soccer stadium in 2022. It's quite an accomplishment and a testament to our capabilities and reputation in the Sports Facilities market.

Currently, we have a crew of over 50 Gephart electricians on-site.

- We are about 75% complete with the installation of the deep underground conduits.
- We are nearly 50% complete with elevated deck pours.
- We are in the process of installing branch wire as well as temporary power and lighting.
- Interior wall framing will begin in early 2025.
- The entire project is expected to be completed in time for the 2027 season.
