Market Update: Healthcare

A sampling of our recently completed and ongoing work.



Hired by JE Dunn Construction, we recently completed the **M Health Fairview Inpatient Addition** in Edina, MN. This 53,000⁺ SF project added 52 private patient rooms on top of the existing Emergency Department.

Working alongside Timco Construction, the team has recently completed the new, 2-story, 44,000 SF Maple Grove Specialty Center, and the new, 16,000 SF, 2-story Wayzata Specialty Center.

Twin Cities Orthopedics - Brooklyn Park is now open. We teamed with RJM Construction for the second time on a TCO project to build this new, 2-story medical office building with clinic space, procedure and x-ray rooms, physical therapy, and training areas.

Work is continuing along at **Altru**, the new, 7-story, 552,000 SF replacement hospital in Grand Forks, ND.

Current work includes switchgear installs, feeder pulls, in-wall roughin, fire alarm conduit, overhead branch and cable tray, mechanical piping, and low-voltage cable pulls to technology distribution rooms.

We also continue to maintain a strong presence at several local hospitals doing routine service, maintenance, and small projects. A few of our long-term clients include M Health Fairview Hospital (Edina, MN), Lakeview Hospital (Stillwater,

MN), Mayo Health Systems (Cannon Falls, MN), North Memorial Medical Center (Robbinsdale, MN), Maple Grove Hospital (Maple Grove, MN), Cambridge Medical Center (Cambridge, MN), and Western Wisconsin Health (Baldwin, WI).

We've also built new relationships with M Health Fairview Lakes (Wyoming, MN), HealthPartners Amery Hospital (Amery, WI), and M Health Fairview Northland Medical Center (Princeton, MN).

These safety helmets provide:




The project also included 22 new digital displays, a new Minnie and Paul celebration sign in center field, and a revolving baseball medallion in right field.
